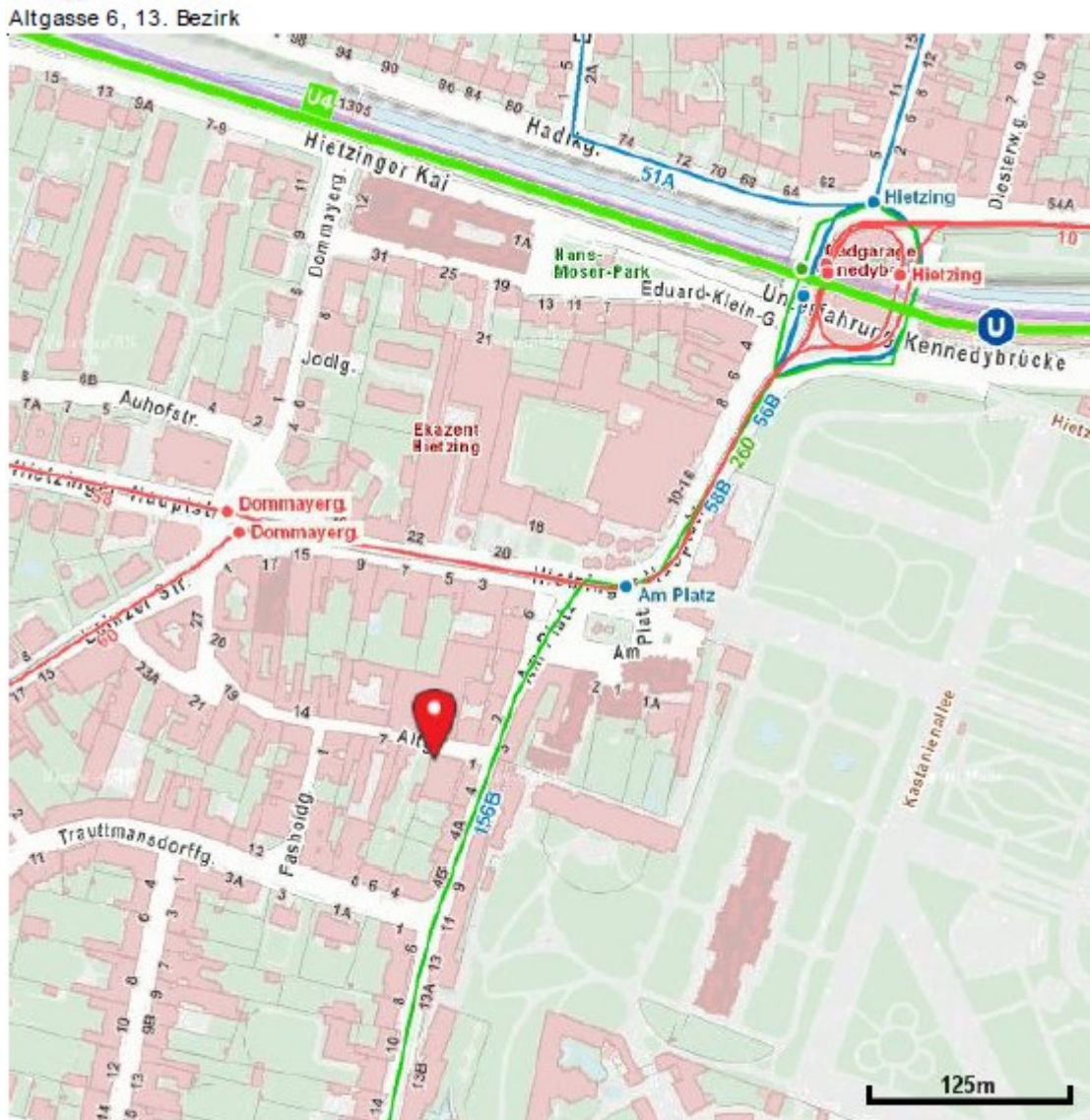
The Kenjutsu training units are set up so that they are also of great interest for Aikidoka wishing to learn or deepen their knowledge about how to work with the Bokken.
